

Coronavirus (COVID-19) Update - 05.05.2020 – No.2

Dear Parents and Carers,

I write following my communication earlier today regarding school operations from next week.

In my letter sent out this afternoon, I indicated that the school has reached capacity as outlined by the NSW DoE on certain days from Week Three – next week.

With this I stated that parents are asked not to send students on days that have not been identified by the home – as per what was indicated by the family in the survey or additional communication that has been provided since the survey was undertaken last week.

There has been a flood of families seeking changes this afternoon following my letter. Our school is not equipped to manage rolling requests that are changing on a daily basis for large numbers of families. In these current unprecedented times, our school is restricted by NSW DoE guidelines that limits the number of students we can have in any one classroom.

Moving Forward

Tomorrow morning, all families will be emailed summaries of what days each child in each class is attending next week – from Monday May 11th. This list will be what the school operations are based on.

Should you wish to make any changes to the days indicated on the class summaries, please send your request to me directly care of the school's email address banorapt-p.school@det.nsw.edu.au .

Please remember, that the school has forged these arrangements from the information you provided that best suited you. No other adjustments will be made at a class or stage level after today 5pm unless it has been approved by me as Principal.

I have had to make this decision as it is not possible to keep making changes at will every day when we are so limited with capacity at school. I hope that you may understand. This is difficult.
