Dear Parents and Carers,

I write to you in relation to the current arrangements for BPPS and visitors to the school site.

No Mass Congregations – COVID-19

Presently the school has asked that parents not enter the school site in the morning or afternoon when either dropping off or picking up students before and after school. This decision is in line with NSW DoE policy and is primarily about avoiding mass congregations of adults on site. Thank you to all parents for your cooperation with this.

As you know NSW DoE policy is based on NSW Health advice. Health advice is that students do not need to physical distance in the same way adults do. It is confusing, however, we all follow government health advice.

What if I need to collect my child during school time?

Sometimes parents and carers need to collect students during the school day for appointments and other reasons. In this situation parents are asked to come into the office and exercise physical distancing as you would in the general public. No problem. You will enter the office as usual sign your child out and then take the slip to the teacher and collect your child. This is all as usual.

Allied Health Professionals / Support Staff Access to School Site

Allied health professionals and support workers are asked at this point to not enter the site. The school will re-consider welcoming allied health professionals and support staff from Wk9. Staff are settling children back into school structures and daily routine over the coming weeks. Thank you for your understanding and patience.
