Public transport services

Glenaeon is serviced by:

School Sydney Buses

- Originating in Manly, Northbridge, Castlecrag, Chatswood and Wynyard – for timetable and route information, go to www.sydneybuses.info/schools

Public Sydney Buses

- From Lane Cove, Gladesville, North Ryde, East Lindfield, Mona Vale and the City – for timetable and route information, go to www.sydneybuses.info/routes

Forest Coaches

Opal card

Eligible students within the Opal network are able to travel to and from school on public transport with the School Opal card. Everyone needs to tap on and off every time, there is no charge but the data they collect supports having the public school bus available for use.

School charter bus services

Glenaeon also charters buses from North Sydney Bus Charters which service the school from the North, East and Inner West suburban areas.

Northern Beaches

- Including Palm Beach, Careel Bay, Avalon, Newport, Mona Vale, Narrabeen and Frenchs Forest.
- This bus drops students at both campuses (as necessary) and collects them in the afternoon.

Eastern Suburbs

- Covering Maroubra, Coogee, Bronte, Waverley, Bondi Junction, Paddington and Fox Studios.
- This bus drops students at both campuses and collects them in the afternoon.

Dulwich Hill/Inner West

- Serviced by a route travelling through Dulwich Hill, Marrickville, Petersham, Camperdown, Annandale and Lilyfield and back to school via the Harbour Bridge.
- This bus drops students at both campuses and collects them in the afternoon.

Balmain/Lane Cove

- Serviced by a route travelling through Balmain, over the Gladesville Bridge to Hunters Hill, Lane Cove, Willoughby and on to Glenaeon School.
- This bus drops students at both campuses (as required) and collects them in the afternoon.

Costs

Travel on all School Charter Bus Services is subsidised by the school but there is a cost per child, which must be paid prior to the beginning of term.

Trips per week	Cost per term
One student	
• Between 5 and 10 trips per week	\$475
• Up to five journeys per week	\$275
Two or more siblings	
• Between 5 and 10 trips per week	\$750
• Third and subsequent siblings ride for free	
• Up to five journeys per week	\$375

Note that the purchase of a full time use ticket means that your child/children can ride any day and will always be assured of a seat.

Seats on these charter buses are limited

so it is wise to register your interest as quickly as possible.

Rules for Students

Transport code of conduct

When travelling to and from school on School Charter Buses and public transport, all Glenaeon students are expected to comply with the Transport Conduct Code in order to ensure their safety and comfort and the safety and comfort of others.

Bus Passes are issued on condition that all students know and understand their obligations as below. You must:

- Behave appropriately and safely at all times
- Remain seated for the duration of your journey with your seatbelt fastened
- Follow the driver's instructions
- If food is consumed it should leave no trace in the bus – this is at the discretion of the bus driver
- Behave politely and kindly to your fellow travellers – there is to be no:
 - Loud and noisy behavior
 - Teasing, bullying or offensive language
 - Placing feet on the seat
- Phones and other electronic devices may only be used with earphones by students in Year 7 and above.
- Older students may not share devices with students in Classes K–6.

Breaches of this Code of Conduct can include consequences such as:

- Formal investigation and interview process
- After school detention (Friday)
- Automatic suspension of bus pass

Parents are requested to share this document with their children in an age appropriate way and encourage them to abide by its rules.

Bus stop supervision

At Middle Cove, a teacher is on duty directly after the end of school at the bus stops at Greenfield Avenue, Victoria Avenue, and Eastern Valley Way.

At Castlecrag, children wait with the duty teacher in the area near the Edinburgh Road gate and are supervised when boarding their bus.

Supervising teachers can be recognised by their fluorescent safety vests.
