INFORMATION FOR FAMILIES

New users must complete an enrolment form prior to booking.

Bookings can only be accepted if:

- **The deposit has been paid (10% of the full fee per child)**
 - All overdue fees are paid in full
- The booking sheet and consent form have been signed and returned

All bookings must be made in person or via email and have the signed consent and booking sheet attached. The deposit can be paid via QKR or Bpoint but **MUST** be referenced as vacation deposit.

You may be required to accept the booking in your MyGov account before the subsidies apply. If your child has not used our service for 14 weeks, you will need to confirm the enrolment through your MyGov account before your subsidy will apply.

Cost: \$60.00 per day

CCS applies for eligible families

It is a legal requirement for children to be signed in and out by an authorised person. This must be done for safety reasons and Child Care Subsidy purposes.

Absences and cancellations

All cancellations must be made 48 hours prior to the day or the full fee will be charged to your account. This is due to staffing arrangements, catering, and excursion/incursion costs.

All cancellations must be made via email, text or phone call.

Late collection

We close at 6:00pm. Late fees will apply for collection after this time. \$10.00 (per child) for the first 15minutes (or part thereof). Any collection after 6:15pm will then incur a \$1.00 per minute late fee

Any late pickup fees will not have the Government subsidy applied as late fees are classed as a penalty and will be charged to the family's account. All late collection fees are charged per child.

Excursions

All children must be at the service half an hour before the listed departure time, in order to have a briefing on the rules and responsibilities and ensure they have all the necessary equipment for a safe and enjoyable excursion.

***Spending money is not permitted**

WHAT TO BRING EACH DAY

FOOD AND DRINK

Please ensure you have provided your children with recess, lunch and drink bottle each day.

Please be aware we are unable to heat up food

Afternoon tea and fresh cold water will be provided. A second snack will be provided for children after 5:00pm

Children must bring their own drink bottle on excursions.

We provide breakfast until 8:00am, afternoon tea, second snack and water every day

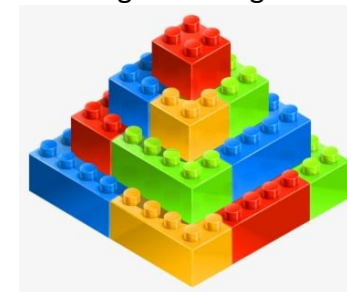
