Dear Families,

Grade 3/4 Dance Club Eisteddfod Performance update

Our preparations for the Dance Eisteddfod are going full steam ahead. There is a lot of very important information contained in this notice. Please take time to read carefully, particularly noting times and **returning the attached slip** with details of how your child will be collected at the end of the day.

The students are working hard and we are very proud of their efforts. We will be the seventh act in a section with eleven primary schools. We will most likely be younger than the other dancers, as most schools take Grade 5 and 6 students. For the majority of our dancers this will be their first experience on a stage in this environment. Therefore, we encourage families to focus discussions on enjoying this wonderful experience and not on winning.

On the day: Friday, 5th July

Please do not drop off students before the 9:00am meeting time, as there will be no staff on Campus until this time. We have had to adjust the time of departure from Huntingfield to the Derwent Entertainment Centre, as the start time for the section has been moved forward from 1:30pm to 12noon, due to the number of acts entering. Therefore, we would appreciate any parent support in having hair and make up prepared before arrival. We would also appreciate any parents with WWVP who can help us in the morning for 1 hour to finish off any hair and make up for those who made need some support in this area. Photos with examples of what is required for hairdos and make up is attached to this notice.

Our schedule for the day on Friday, 5th July is as follows (all times are approximate)

- Arrive at the Huntingfield Campus at 9:00am and meet in the Drama Room.
- 9:00am we will gather together and begin doing hair and make up. We will have some recess during this time.
- 10:00am depart for Derwent Entertainment Centre (DEC) on the College Bus.
- 10:45am arrive at DEC and move to the change room allocated to St Aloysius. We will have a separate space available for boys to change in. We will change into our costumes and possibly have a practice back stage.
- 12:00pm the Primary Schools Section commences. Anyone watching the performance will need to arrive before 12noon.
- We will most likely be back stage until the Primary Schools section concludes.
- After the dance, we will have a group photo, change out of our costumes then enter the auditorium to watch the Secondary School section.
- We estimate this section will finish between 3-3:30pm. We will meet parents in the foyer of the DEC once we have retrieved our belongings from the change room at the end of the Secondary Schools section.
