Dear Parents and Guardians,

Grade 3/4 Dance Club - Final Eisteddfod Performance notice

We have just three weeks until Eisteddfod performance day. Below are some final important pieces of information for families in preparation for event day.

PRACTICE AT HUNTINGFIELD

Next Friday, 21st June we will be transporting the Dance Club to Huntingfield Campus during the afternoon teaching block (1.00pm-2.45pm). This will enable the group to have a practice on the Drama Room stage, giving the students a taste of what it is like to perform on a raised, large theatre stage with curtains and lighting. **If your child is bringing their own stockings and/or jazz shoes on Eisteddfod day, please send them to school for this rehearsal day.**

DRESS REHEARSAL

There will also be a full dress rehearsal and performance for the Grade 3 and Grade 4 students after lunch on Wednesday, 26th June. We will start the performance around 1.40pm. Parents are welcome to come along and watch on this day. **If your child is bringing their own stockings and/or jazz shoes on Eisteddfod day, please send them to school for this dress rehearsal.**

IMPORTANT CHANGES ON EISTEDDFOD DAY

Due to the number of students involved and the earlier start time for our section on performance day, we are asking students to arrive at the **Huntingfield Drama room between 8.30am-9.00am.**

PERFORMANCE DAY MAKE UP AND HAIR

A reminder that families are **not expected to purchase make up** for this event. Families are also not required to do hair and make up, unless you feel confident to do so. We have volunteers to help with these things on performance day and families should not feel stressed about preparation. Students who need assistance will receive it at the Huntingfield Drama Room, before we depart for the Derwent Entertainment Centre.

Our performance and finishing times are very much an estimate. It is very hard to predict times. We estimate we will perform around 12.20pm. As the doors close between acts, we recommend that families arrive before the start of the Eisteddfod's afternoon session at 12.00pm.

Our group will be watching the Secondary Dance performances after our section is complete. We estimate the Secondary section will finish between 3.00pm-3:30pm. **Families who are collecting students from the bus at the Kingston Campus are required be at the campus NO LATER THAN 4.00PM.** Please be aware that there is a small chance that students may arrive a little later, should there be delays at the Derwent Entertainment Centre.
