A WORD OF POPE FRANCIS

"For those who are his witnesses, Jesus is more than a historical personage; he is a living person; he is newness, not things we have already seen, the newness of the future and not a memory from the past. The witness, then, is not someone who knows the story of Jesus, but one who has experienced a love story with Jesus. The witness, in the end, proclaims only this: that Jesus is alive and that he is the secret of life. Indeed Peter, after saying: 'You are the Christ', then goes on to say: 'the Son of the living God'. Witness arises from an encounter with the living Jesus. At the centre of Paul's life too, we find that same word that rises up from Peter's heart: Christ. Paul repeats that name constantly, almost four hundred times in his letters. For him Christ is not only a model, an example, a point of reference: he is life itself. He writes, 'For me to live is Christ'. Jesus is Paul's present and his future, so much so that he considers the past as refuse in comparison to the surpassing knowledge of Jesus Christ."
