A WORD OF POPE FRANCIS

"Jesus asks us to keep our lamps alight so that we can light up the darkness of the night. In other words we are invited to live a mature, authentic faith that is able to light up the many 'nights' in our lives. We know, all of us, that sometimes there are times of spiritual darkness. The light of faith has to be continually nourished to be kept alight – with a heart to heart encounter with Jesus in prayer and in listening to the Word. Let me repeat something I have said before; always have a small copy of the Gospel near you – in your pocket or your handbag – and read it. It's a meeting with Jesus through his Word. This will help us be aware of others and their needs and will be a lamp to light up our path."
