St Aloysius Catholic College will be holding a Family Maths Night in term four. The night is for families with students from Kindergarten to Grade 4. The session will take place on Wednesday, 30th October in the Sisters of Charity Centre, starting at 6:00pm and finishing no later than 7:30pm.

The Family Maths Night is a wonderful opportunity for the College to introduce Parents and Guardians to the methods of teaching Mathematics in the classroom, giving parents support with ideas and strategies on how to assist students at home with Maths.
