The KSC, with the direct support of the Parish, will launch the *New Immigrant Support Program* on the weekend of Saturday 19<sup>th</sup> and Sunday 20<sup>th</sup> October. The *New Immigrant Support Program* is a Parish-based program designed to welcome and help new immigrants settle in our parish and become and remain members of our vibrant Catholic community. For the Program to be successful, it will require our Parish community working and networking together to assist new immigrants over some of the key hurdles that they face in their first couple of years. The Program will also work in partnership with the St Vincent de Paul Society and Catholic Care Tasmania for the delivery and support of certain services.

**Key areas of the Parish-based program include:** Cultural Awareness and Integration; English language training; Affordable accommodation; Part time employment opportunities and preparation of Job applications and CVs; Immigrants skills/qualifications specific work experience opportunities leading to full-time employment; Catholic education for children; and short-term emergency financial support.

For this Program to be successful, we need volunteers who can be actively involved in leading or supporting one or more of these specific areas of the Program.

After all Masses on the weekend of 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> October the KSC will be seeking parishioners support and commitment to assist in the Program. Please walk a moment in immigrants' shoes and then think and act on how you can help our new brothers and sisters in our community.
