**Justice Day Cup Cake Fundraiser

On Wednesday, 23rd October, the Kingston Campus classes will be focusing on a social justice issue for the Sisters of Charity Social Justice Week. This term we will be looking at the parable Jesus shared of 'The Good Samaritan', and discussing how we can care for others, in our local community and our global community. The three Kindergarten classes have decided to hold a Cup Cake Stall, as a fundraiser for the Tu Bong Orphanage, in Vietnam.

Mrs. Reece visited the orphanage in 2017 and was impressed with their vision to support orphans of the community to have a home until they reach 16 years of age. They will not be adopted out to other countries and are well cared for by local community members. However, it is a costly exercise and they rely on fundraising to support all of their needs.

Last year, the Kinder classes raised over \$700 which was used to support the orphanage in providing play equipment for the children. This year, the orphanage is hoping to provide an educator for the children.
