Grade 10 Exams

Attached is the Grade 10 exam timetable for 2019. Students have been briefed on the requirements and procedures for the exams. However, please note the following:

- Students have a study day on Friday November 22nd. Students are encouraged to study at home. Any students attending the College will be supervised and must come to school in full school uniform.
- Students are to wear school uniform and leavers top or blazer to exams. HPE uniform should not be worn. Students must remain on campus between morning and afternoon exam sessions.
- Any students who do not have an exam on Tuesday 26th November have a further study day. Students with only one exam on this day must provide written permission to Mrs Natasha Harris if they are arriving for the afternoon session or leaving the College after their morning exam.
- A catch up day on Friday 28th November has been allocated for any students who are unwell or unable to sit exams during the scheduled times.
- Thursday 28th November is the final day for Grade 10 students. Students should arrive at the College for morning Home Room, clean up and a final grade assembly. Students will then be transported to Kingston Campus for a Graduation Mass rehearsal. Students will be dismissed from the Kingston Campus just before lunch. Students can wear casual clothes on their final day.
- The Grade 10 Graduation Mass is held on the evening of Thursday 28th at Christ The Priest church.
- It is also an expectation that all Grade 10 students attend the College Final Thanksgiving Liturgy on Tuesday 17th December. College and subject awards are presented at this liturgy and Grade 10s are farewelled by the College community. Students must wear formal College uniform including their blazer.

Students are encouraged to prepare appropriately for their final exams. Teachers use exams to consolidate their evaluation of each student's achievement during the year before allocating final grades. Most importantly the exam week also provides our students with the experience of sitting formal exams before they enter Grade 11.
