A WORD OF POPE FRANCIS

"Luke tells us that all four people have a two-fold connection - one of movement and one of wonder. Mary & Joseph go towards Jerusalem; for his part Simeon, moved by the Spirit, goes to the temple, while Anna serves God continuously, day and night. So all four protagonists in the story show us that the Christian life requires this readiness to move, to be led by the Holy Spirit. To remain stationary is not helpful to Christian witness, nor to the mission of the Church. The world needs Christians who are prepared to get moving, to never tire of walking the ways of life, to bring to all the consoling message of Jesus. Every baptized person has received a calling to proclaim, to proclaim something, to proclaim Jesus. Parishes and the different parish groups are called to give prominence to young people, families and the elderly, so that all can have this genuine Christian experience, to live and proclaim the life and mission of Jesus and the Church."
