VET Construction lessons will re-commence at GYC on Tuesday, 26th May 2020.

Workshop lessons are at Guilford Young College, Barrack St Campus, every Tuesday middle block. These sessions are during scheduled Huntingfield elective lessons. Therefore, students will not be missing core subject time.

Each Tuesday St Aloysius will provide taxi transport to and from Guilford Young College during recess and lunch breaks.
