Dear Families,

On Friday 12 February 2020 the Tasmanian Government declared Tullamarine Airport in Melbourne a COVID-19 high risk area.

We have been advised by Public Health that any student who transited through Tullamarine under the following circumstances must comply with the associated directions:

- Terminal 4 at Tullamarine Melbourne Airport at any time on Tuesday 9 February, must not enter St Aloysius Catholic College, self-isolate immediately and call the Public Health Hotline on 1800 671 738 for further advice including to arrange testing.
- Any area of Tullamarine Melbourne Airport on Sunday 7 and Monday 8 February, must monitor their health and call the Public Health Hotline on 1800 671 738 to arrange for a COVID-19 test if cold or flu symptoms are detected.

Further to the above, Public Health has, over the weekend, expanded its lists of Victorian and NSW high risk premises and locations.

Any student who has been in any of the listed locations or premises in the last 14 days must immediately self-isolate and call the Public Health hotline on 1800 671 758.

The above directions regarding not entering St Aloysius Catholic College and self-isolation do not apply to family members or close associates of returned travellers from designated high-risk areas unless that person (the traveller) returns a positive result for a COVID-19 test.
